**Course Syllabus**

**Name of the Course: The Angles, The Anchor, The Answers: Defending and Sharing Your Faith**

**Instructor: Various**

**Overall Course Objective.** Equipping believers to defend their faith when challenged, and to share their faith without waiting to be challenged. Doing so comfortably, competently, and confidently.

**Course Description.** Each week will address a different Angle, Anchor, and Answer using themes any believer encounters daily. The way you defend your belief is Anchored in scripture, which support why you believe, what you believe.

**Duration of the Course.** This course will span eleven weeks, with ten weeks of course instruction.

**Specific Learning Objectives:**

As a result, this class will equip the participant to give a reason for his or her hope in Christ, as the only way to salvation. The participant will understand God's sovereign destiny to fulfill His desire for those who accept Him and to spend eternity with Him.

**Read and meditate on God's Word daily.**

- 1) Read Everyday Apologetics. A 100 Day Journey in Defending the Faith, by Stan Lewis
- 2) Identify and counter a major hindrance in his/her life to believing God.

**Weekly:** There are ten (10) teaching sessions covering an eleven-week period. Each weekly topic is described below.

**Textbook: The Holy Bible.**

<b>Date</b>	<b>Topic/Description</b>
Session I - Sept 10th	This session is the Kick-off 'Call to Action' with a guest presenter. There will be an overview of the course addressing the themes of the Sovereignty, Scripture, Savior, Salvation, and Spirit.
Session 2 - Sept 17 <sup>th</sup>	<b>The Sovereign: GOD.</b> Existence, evidence, character, and efficacy of God
Session 3 - Sept 24 <sup>th</sup>	<b>The Sovereign: GOD</b> The Justice of God in view of all the injustices in the world; good versus evil
Session 4 - Oct 1 <sup>st</sup>	<b>The Scripture: BIBLE</b> Trustworthiness and veracity of scripture; is it really the Word of God?
Session 5 - Oct 8 <sup>th</sup>	<b>The Scripture: BIBLE.</b> Is the Bible only a White Man's document?
Session 6 - Oct. 15 <sup>th</sup>	<b>The Son of God/Savior: Jesus</b> Deity; is Jesus God or just a prophet? Is He the Messiah? Is He central to our hope?
Oct. 22 <sup>nd</sup>	COUNTYWIDE REVIVAL
Session 7 - Oct 29 <sup>th</sup>	<b>The Son of God/Savior: Jesus.</b> Is He the only way? Did He really get up?
Session 8 - Nov. 5 <sup>th</sup>	<b>Salvation.</b> Atonement/Forgiveness
Session 9 - Nov. 12 <sup>th</sup>	<b>Salvation.</b> Resurrection (Did Jesus rise from the dead?) Eternal Life (Can you lose your salvation?) Heaven (Are heaven and hell real destinations?)
Session 10 - Nov. 19 <sup>th</sup>	<b>Holy Spirit.</b> His identity and His role in a believer's life and the church? Is there really a Holy Spirit? Is there a Trinity and how does it work?
